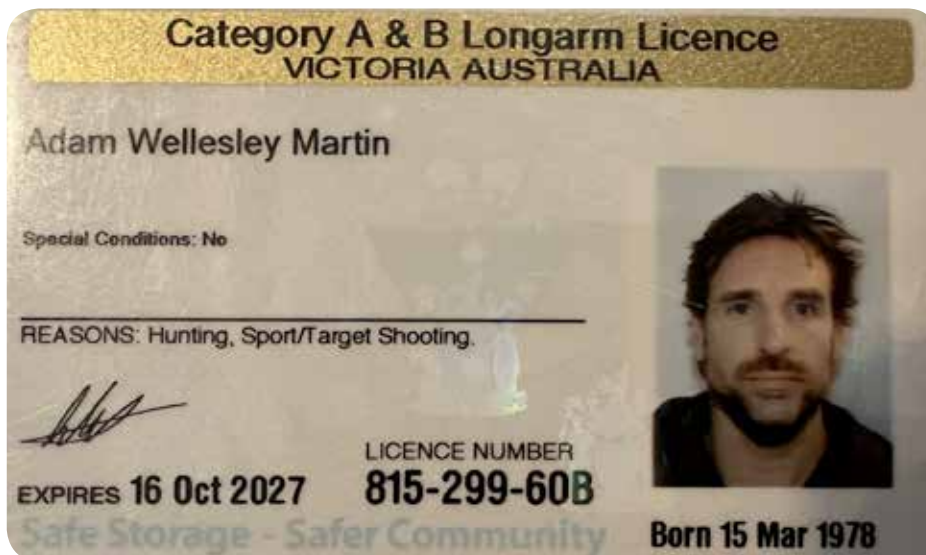
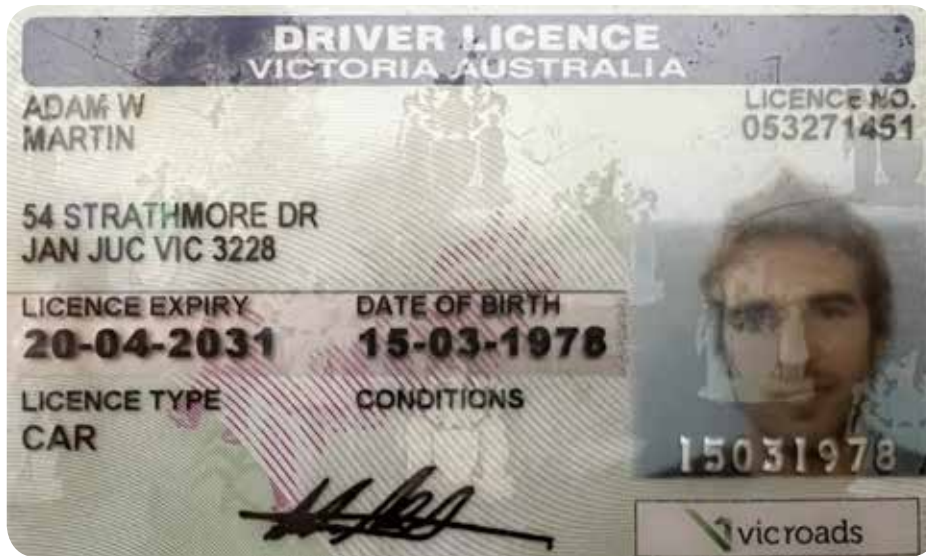

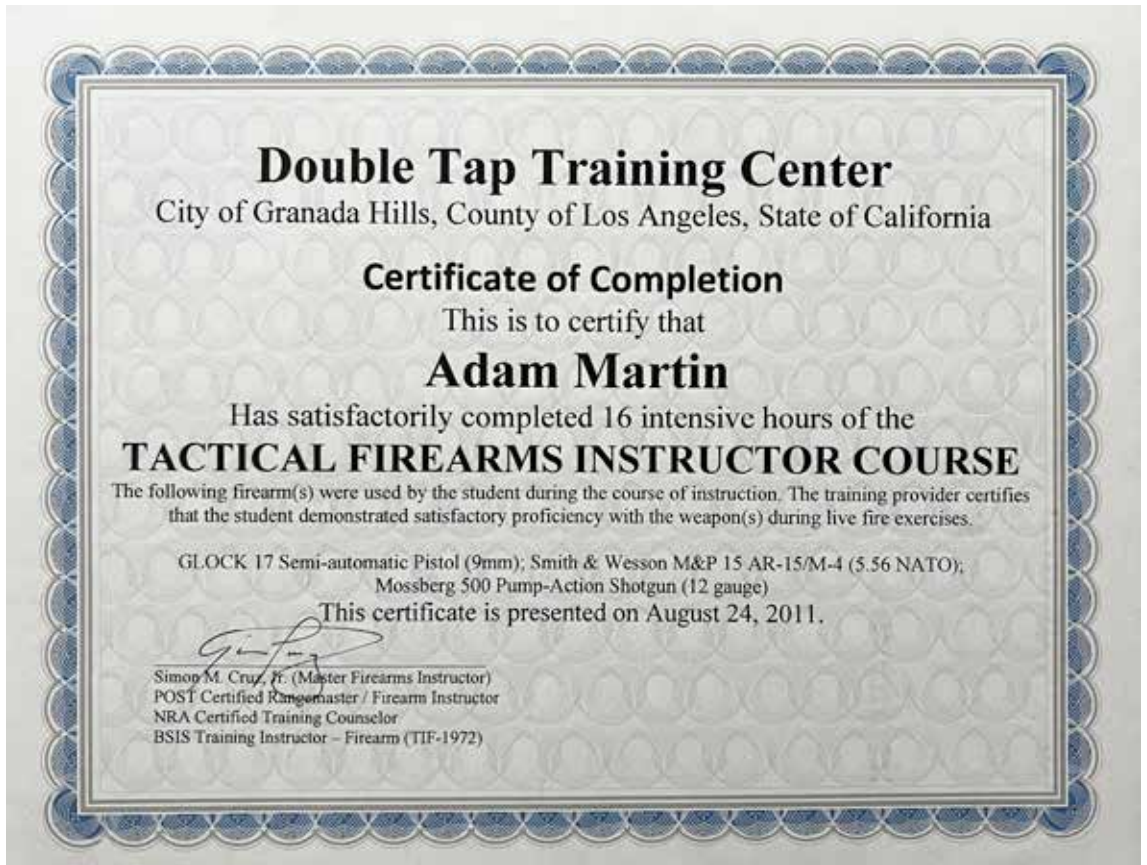

The Glock Armourer certification covers proper operation, maintenance and repair of Glock pistols.



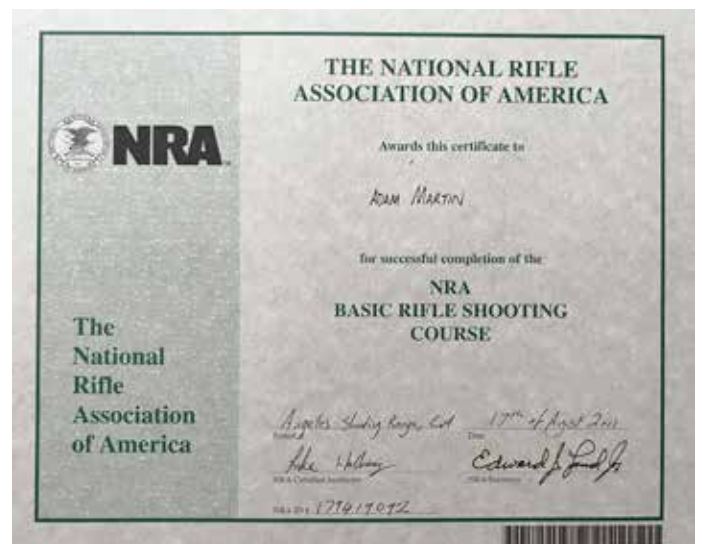
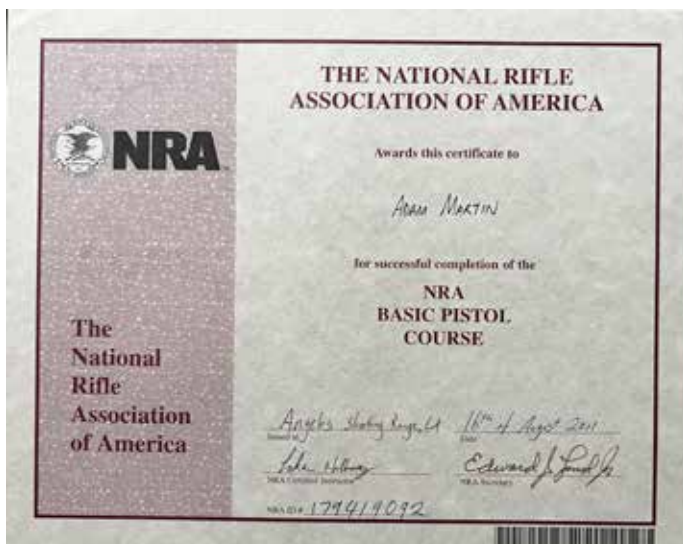
